### **Cincinnati Revolution to host Salute to Service Night on July 11**

**CINCINNATI, Ohio (July 8, 2015)** – The Cincinnati Revolution will host a Salute to Service Night on Saturday, July 11 at their game against the Pittsburgh Thunderbirds. Salute to Service is held in honor of military members, police and firefighters, and they will receive free entry to the game. Pre-game activities will begin at 7:30 p.m. at the University of Cincinnati's Sheakley Athletic Complex.
