Military Veterans Resource Center announces new appointment to board of directors

Chillicothe, Ohio (April 13, 2015) – Military Veterans Resource Center today announced the addition of Don Mundy of Chillicothe, Ohio to its Board of Directors.

Mundy currently serves as the pastor of Tyler United Methodist Church and is the chaplain for VFW Post 108. He is a U.S. Marine Corps veteran who served in the Vietnam War from 1967 until 1968. After his service in the Marine Corps, he joined the 656th Transportation Company, U. S. Army Reserves, where he served for eleven years.

Over the years, Mundy has remained active in Chillicothe's veterans community. He is currently the recording secretary for the Ross County Veterans Council and assists with the annual Ross County Homeless Awareness Day. He also serves on the board of directors for the Greater Scioto Valley Habitat for Humanity, the Greater Scioto Valley Emmaus Community and Veterans in Transition, Inc. He is a member of the American Legion, Disabled Veterans of America and the Chillicothe Lions Club.

"Don brings diverse experience and a valuable perspective to our Board. We are fortunate to have his guidance as we continue to grow in our mission," said MVRC Executive Director Len Proper.

Mundy's appointment expands the MVRC Board of Directors from seven to eight members. Over the coming months, MVRC will continue its search for additional members committed to the cause of helping Ohio's veterans and their families.
