Free tax filing assistance available for veterans until April 18

COLUMBUS, Ohio (April 6, 2016) – Tax filing season ends Monday, April 18, but until then veterans, service members and families can file their federal and state income taxes free of charge with Military Veterans Resource Center. The only requirements are that veterans and spouses filing jointly must have an adjusted gross income of \$95,000 or less and everyone else must have an adjusted gross income of \$65,000 or less.

The free tax filing service is available at Military Veterans Resource Center's Columbus office, located at 1395 E. Dublin-Granville Rd., Ste. 350. To schedule an appointment, contact Herb Jones at 614-636-4634 or herb.jones@milvetsrc.org.

Those who do not bring the necessary documentation will not be able to file. Veterans will need to bring a photo ID, their DD-214 (or other evidence of military service), and their income tax records. A full list of required documents is available at milvetsrc.org/taxes.
