Veterans Career Workshop set for Wednesday, April 22

COLUMBUS, Ohio (March 16, 2015) – Military Veterans Resource Center invites all job seeking veterans to attend a Veterans Career Workshop on Wednesday, April 22. Veterans Service Specialists will help veterans jumpstart their careers by teaching them to become more competitive candidates and improving their job search skills. This event is free of charge and will take place at MVRC's office, located at 1395 E. Dublin-Granville Rd., Ste. 350. It will run from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., with lunch included.

“We’ll work with vets one-on-one and make sure they’re prepared to communicate their skills and experiences to civilian employers,” said MVRC Executive Director Len Proper. “Many past participants have received interview invitations and job offers soon after completing the workshop.”

Veterans who already have resumes should bring them, as they will spend time revising their current resume or writing a new one. Veterans Service Specialists will also conduct mock interview sessions and help the participants improve their interview skills.
