Veterans Career Workshop set for Jan. 28

HAMILTON, Ohio (Jan. 7, 2015) – Military Veterans Resource Center invites job seeking veterans to attend a Veterans Career Workshop on Wednesday, Jan. 28, 2015. Career Specialists will help veterans jumpstart their careers by teaching them to become more competitive candidates and improving their job search skills. This event is free of charge and will take place at MVRC's Hamilton office, located at 914 Ross Ave. It will run from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., with lunch included.

“We’ll work with vets one-on-one and make sure they’re prepared to communicate their skills and experiences to civilian employers,” said MVRC Executive Director Len Proper. “Many past participants have received interview invitations and job offers soon after completing the workshop.”

Veterans who already have resumes should bring them, as they will spend time revising their current resume or writing a new one. Local employers will also attend to conduct mock interview sessions and help the participants improve their interview skills.
