Veterans Tax Day set for April 4

CHILLICOTHE, Ohio (March 10, 2016) – On Monday, April 4, veterans, service members and families can file their federal and state income taxes free of charge at Military Veterans Resource Center's Veterans Tax Day. The only requirements are that veterans and spouses filing jointly have an adjusted gross income of \$95,000 or less, and everyone else have an adjusted gross income of \$65,000 or less.

Veterans Tax Day will take place at the Ross County Service Center, located at 475 Western Ave., meeting room B. Appointments will be available from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. To schedule an appointment, contact Brandon Taylor at 740-835-5145 or brandon.taylor@milvetsrc.org.

Those who do not bring the necessary documentation will not be able to file. Veterans will need to bring a photo ID, their DD-214 (or other evidence of military service), and their income tax records. A full list of required documents is available at milvetsrc.org/taxes.
