Veterans Tax Night set for April 16

HAMILTON, Ohio (March 21, 2016) – On Saturday, April 16, veterans, service members and families can file their federal and state income taxes free of charge at Military Veterans Resource Center's Veterans Tax Night. The only requirements are that veterans and spouses filing jointly have an adjusted gross income of \$95,000 or less, and everyone else have an adjusted gross income of \$65,000 or less.

Veterans Tax Night will take place at Military Veterans Resource Center's Hamilton office, located at 633 High St., Ste. 101. Appointments will be available from 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. Thanks to Domino's, pizza will also be served free of charge to Veterans Tax Night attendees, available on a first come first serve basis. Those who do not bring the necessary documentation will not be able to file. Veterans will need to bring a photo ID, their DD-214 (or other evidence of military service), and their income tax records. A full list of required documents is available at milvetsrc.org/taxes.
