Military Veterans Resource Center To Host Veterans Career Workshop

SPRINGFIELD, OH (April 29, 2014) – Military Veterans Resource Center invites all veterans looking for a new career to attend our free Veterans Career Workshop on Thursday, May 29. This career workshop will take place at MVRC’s Springfield office, which is located at 1920 Kenton St. It will run from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., with a job search session in the computer lab to follow from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m. Lunch will be provided.

This personalized, interactive workshop is designed to improve veterans’ job-search skills. MVRC career specialists will lead the workshop and will teach cover letter and resume writing and conduct practice interviews. If veterans have a resume, they should bring it, as they will spend time revising their current resume or writing a new one.

The Veterans Career Workshop will be a group setting, but participants will receive individualized attention. The career specialists will work with veterans one-on-one to address their questions and help make sure they are better prepared for their job search.
