Military Veterans Resource Center provides Thanksgiving care packages to vets in need

HAMILTON, Ohio (Nov. 21, 2014) – On Nov. 21, 2014, Military Veterans Resource Center’s Hamilton office, located at 914 Ross Ave., distributed Thanksgiving care packages to veterans and their families in need.

Each box included a complete Thanksgiving meal with a whole turkey, mashed potatoes and gravy, stuffing, yams, beans, fruit, rolls, and a pie. The turkeys were provided by AMVETS Post 1983 and the side items were donated by Military Veterans Resource Center.

“Ten turkey boxes were handed out today,” said the Hamilton office’s Career Specialist, Dan Dunaway. “One of the families who received a box has six children to feed.”

This is the second year MVRC has provided Thanksgiving dinners to veterans. Both years, the staff contacted veteran clients experiencing significant needs and offered the turkey dinners as a way to help ease the burden of holiday expenses.

“The veterans were very appreciative,” said Dunaway. “These care packages are helping to make Thanksgiving a special time for their families.”
