### **Military Veterans Resource Center's Career Workshop To Help Unemployed Vets Find Jobs**

CHILLICOTHE, Ohio (Oct. 14, 2014) – Military Veterans Resource Center invites job seeking veterans to attend a career workshop on Wednesday, Nov. 12, 2014. Career specialists will help veterans jumpstart their careers by improving their job search skills and teaching them how to become more competitive candidates. This event is free of charge and will take place at MVRC's Chillicothe office, located at 1786 N. Bridge St. It will run from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., with lunch included.

"We'll work with vets one-on-one and make sure they're prepared to communicate their skills and experiences to civilian employers," said MVRC Executive Director Len Proper. "Many past participants have received interview invitations and job offers soon after completing the workshop."

Veterans who already have resumes should bring them, as they will spend time revising their current resume or writing a new one. For those interested in becoming self-employed, a session on how to launch your own business will also be covered at the end.
